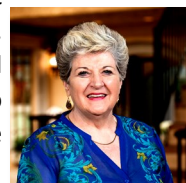
WM Picnic and Swimming

Pastor's goals for GTAG in 2019

The Lord has laid on my heart some goals for GTAG that I have shared from the pulpit, but want to share with you again so that we keep these before us as we prepare for this year on ministry and outreach.

- First is that every person that is part of GTAG be Spirit-filled and Spirit-led. If we are going to make a difference in our world IT'S GOING TO REQUIRE THE HOLY SPIRIT working through us to do it.
- I want to see our church grow in prayer! I want to see those participating in our prayer ministry at least double, as well have people coming during the week and before services to pray and to our Sunday PM services where I have made it a priority to set aside time for prayer.
